





Parish Council Report

Palm Cross New Development

At its special meeting on the 19th October Modbury Parish Council decided to accept the offer from the developers (Bloor) of the new 30 space car park that will be built next to Palm Cross Green. The new car park will be built and operational before the existing car park is landscaped. The Parish Council also agreed to ask that Bloor

- redesign the employment building to make it less dominant near the Green,
- improve the appearance of the old Fire Station and provide an entrance from the new car park,
- consider allowing access from the development into the Green should we wish to provide additional parking spaces.

Modbury will receive £215,390 for specific sports and recreation projects from the Section 106 agreement that has been agreed between the developers and South Hams District Council, all of which are at the QE11 Recreation Field. Unfortunately it seems that no provision has been made in the agreement to relocate the Memorial Hall playing area to the Green, which has been an aspiration of the Council for some time. We are still looking at ways to achieve this.

We have been told that work will commence on site shortly, with the first houses expected to be completed in the middle of next year.



Palm Cross Green Development—Your Opportunity to Take Part!

South Hams District Council have confirmed that **four new street names** will be required for the new development west of Palm Cross Green, Church Street, Modbury (for 93 new homes and 3 employment units (Planning application: 35/0059/15/F)). They have invited the Modbury Parish Council to make suggestions before formally submitting their application to South Hams District Council. On p11 opposite is a plan showing the layout and highlighting the four streets. At the last Parish Meeting four themes were suggested for naming these streets (which are set out below) so we are now inviting you to cast your votes and have your say!

Wool Town—Lucy Brown suggested that we should pick up on the fact that Modbury has historically been associated with the wool industry and suggested wool themed names in light of the fact that some field names locally are linked to the wool industry such as **Yarnhay** and **Rack Park**. The register of the Parish Clerk in 1700 showed 4 Clothiers: **Dowton**, **Gest**, **Legassick** and **Colling**. With this in mind she suggested the following names as potential new street names: **Distaff**, **Spindle**, **Tenterhooks**, **Comber**, **Carder** - (we already have Scalders Lane, Tuckers Brook and Fullers Ope).

Lords of the Manor—Mark Lawrence made two suggestions as follows: As the land in question was once part of the Manor of Modbury (along with Palm Cross Green), we have **Champernowne** already. We could use later Lords of the Manor's names such as the **Legassick** family; When their male line died out the title went to **Crespin**. He sold the Manor House to **Coyte** who immediately passed on the title to **Pode** and then to **Rogers** (who confusingly was called the last Portreeve, another historic title, and from whom the PC "bought" Palm Cross Green in 1963. The first two suggestions certainly owned the land; the latter two were the guardians of the Green.

French Connection—Alternatively, as Modbury is twinned with Le Faou and Lanveoc it would be a nice gesture to perhaps use these names as both of these towns have a "Rue de Modbury". It would be nice to have a **Lanveoc Close** or **Le Faou Close** or similar.

Historic Enclosures—Brian Weeks brought the following additions and research into the mix: "Road names in Modbury almost always reflect a connection with a local historical place name, a personage of high standing, a local feature, past usage or the name of an enclosure, for example, **Benedict Way/Tuckers Brook / Ayleston Park / The Priory / Champernowne / The Orchard /L ong Park / Silverwell Park / Poundwell / Cromwell Park** etc. (Park – meaning: enclosure/field/estate). New Road is not particularly inspiring but apt at the time I suppose!

Some may be aware of my repeated suggestions during the RA1 consultations of adopting the historical names of the enclosures within the curtilage of the site for the naming of the roads. It imbues a sense of acknowledging the locality, respect for the history of the Parish and its people and may help to create a better sense of integration into the Town.

References: Transcript of a map of the Legassick Park produced in 1740, Tithe schedules, The meticulous records and researches made by the late Jo James.

Names of enclosures estimated to be within the RA1 curtilage:

Southern Close (comprises Higher Green Park and Lower Green Park), **Gees Field, Easter Moyles, Moyles Park** (comprises Higher Meadow and Lower Meadow), **Wester Moyles Park**, **Groom Gardens** (site of Kaydon), **Pearse Gardens** (site of existing Palm Cross car park).

Adjacent/included unsure? Barn Park/Oat Park, Three Corners Park, 15 - Little Orchard. New Mills Lane should remain as such. Final verifications would be needed by the Modbury History Society/ owners deeds/Rural Archive/ Devon Records Office/Local knowledge."




