#### **Modbury Neighbourhood Plan**

As most of you will be aware, the draft Joint Local Plan which combines South Hams, Plymouth and West Devon has now been published. In the plan, Modbury has been designated as a Local Centre and has been given a provisional allocation of a further 80 houses in addition to the 20 allocated for the RA2 site (Poundwell). The SHDC preferred site is on land adjoining the current development at Palm Cross Green.

There is concern both that Modbury has been allocated more housing than other Local Centres and that it exceeds local need. Worryingly, the proposed new site could in fact accommodate significantly more houses than the proposed 80, thus giving the possibility of pressure for further development. These proposals have significant implications for the character of the town and for the ability of the infrastructure to absorb further large development.

The consensus of opinions gathered so far by way of public consultations and the recent public meeting called by the Parish Council (chaired by Gary Streeter MP), is that the preference of the community is for smaller, mixed developments introduced in phases and in keeping with the character of the town.

We are also aware of a report by WYG, Planning Consultants for Bloor Homes, indicating their longer term intentions to develop other land around Modbury if they can obtain planning permission. The report challenges the figures from SHDC, claiming that housing need is significantly higher than has been specified in the Joint Local Plan.

The view of the Neighbourhood Plan Group is that such development, were it allowed, would significantly and unacceptably alter the character and balance of the community.

There are two separate issues here:

- 1. Negotiation with SHDC over numbers and the mode of delivery of housing proposed under the JLP. We are keen to ensure that we are suggesting positive alternatives that could work for us. We believe there is potential for good quality development on a manageable scale and we have been looking at how this has been achieved in other communities.
- 2. The aspirations of a developer for development which is not indicated or justified in the SHDC figures.

Representatives of the Neighbourhood Plan Group and the Parish Council are meeting with our District Councillor, Lindsay Ward, and the newly appointed Strategic Planner from SHDC to discuss both the proposed housing allocation and the potential threat from developers.

There will be questions about housing provision and development included in the **Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire which is being delivered to every household. Please make sure that you complete these.** They are an important part of the evidence which goes to make up the Neighbourhood Plan which is to be submitted to South Hams District Council for inclusion in the overall plan which covers the period to 2034.

As a community we need to co-ordinate our information and efforts so please send comments or suggestions via the Neighbourhood Plan website (www.modburynpg.co.uk), or written comments addressed to the NPG at the Parish Office.

At the time of going to press, the date of the NPG October meeting has not been finalised. This will be posted on the website and on the Parish noticeboard.

#### **Parish Council Report**

This month's Parish Council meeting saw a larger attendance from the general public than I had witnessed since becoming a councillor. This was brought about by the recent revelation by Bloor Homes advising that they had acquired a controlling interest in land around Modbury including the RA1 development site which could be enough land to accommodate probably about 400 houses if planning were to be granted. The Parish Council has agreed to put together a working party to address what we see as alien to Modbury's wishes. The public meeting a few weeks ago suggested and it was agreed that small pockets of development would be acceptable but not another major development which could easily turn into another separate Modbury divorced from the old Modbury. The Parish Council will do all they can to oppose Bloor's aspirations but it may well mean that we would need advice from a planning expert. A meeting has been arranged by Cllr Lindsay Ward with the South Hams Strategic Planning Officer, the meeting will be attended by two members of the Parish Council and members of the Neighbourhood Plan Group.

I would like to thank Ann Turner for her presentation to the meeting on the work the NP Group had done over the last few months. Also present was Thelma Rumsey who gave us a short talk on the Tree Wardens' Network advising us that Burda Gage was going to act as second tree warden for Modbury. A new Community Police Officer was present and reported a 50% drop in crime around the Modbury area and that some arrests had been made.

There were only two planning applications to discuss and decide on this month. It was decided to purchase a new Union flag for the flag pole as the old one was old and weathered. As the Scouts are going to take over the Marley building it was decided to take back the old fire station that is situated on Palm Cross Green for the storage of emergency and some flood defence equipment and also for storing some machinery used in the Millennium Meadow.

#### 1. Joint Local Plan update

During the summer I read all your responses to the Joint Local Plan. Your responses were thoughtful and heartfelt just like at the July meeting. It is clear there is a united voice on this issue.

At the July meeting I said that I would bring a strategic planner to Modbury (see my presentation notes from that meeting on Modbury Parish Council website). Your collective response helped me to make the case for further engagement with the strategic planning officers ahead of the creation of the draft version of the Joint Local Plan.

The new lead officer has visited Modbury to take time reviewing the sites and at my invite is attending a meeting with representatives of the Parish Council and the Neighbourhood Plan Group who have been keen to meet with him. They have explained the ideas that they are putting to him at the recent Parish Council meeting – I urge you to support this critical process. We will be exploring how the two processes – Neighbourhood Planning and the Joint Local Plan might sit together.

Please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any comments to make or queries. I will keep the Parish Council updated on the schedule. The next version of the Joint Local Plan (the formal draft) will be consulted on later this year. I will hold a surgery on this matter within the next month and will post notice of the date with the Parish Council.


