MEMORIAL HALL PROJECT UPDATE



'A Community Hall Fit for All'

It has been less than two months since work started and now we have an extension to the Memorial Hall! All that remains in the coming week (5th Dec) is to block pave the path to the playground, put a final coat of paint on the rendered outside wall and generally tidy the rest of the outside. The electrician also has lights to fit but we should get the keys this week.

We are extremely grateful to our builder, Martin Shergold, and his team who have not only produced exactly what we wanted but also in time and under budget all of which has made this a relatively pain free experience. At the same time (and within the overall budget) Martin has undertaken numerous small remedial maintenance jobs, which will go a long way towards making the building easier to look after for the next few years.

The Pantomime/Players will now be able to use the new stage door from next week and begin to think about how to use the storage.

On the rest of the project I am pleased to report that the kitchen is complete except for some tiles (which will go up this week) and being used. Also we now have free wifi for Hall users. This together with the projector and screen make the Hall a much more desirable venue for meetings and presentations and we are already seeing this reflected in future bookings.

There are a number of events taking place in the Hall during the year, we hope to see you at one of them soon and we wish you all a very Happy New Year.

Parish Council Report

The Council meeting on 12th December welcomed our new council member Mr Bruce Hathesley.

A report into the state of the play park at the Memorial Hall was discussed and it was decided that the multi play unit would be removed as it was beyond economic repair. This would happen as soon as possible with the steel being donated to Modbury Caring to raise money from its scrap value. The remaining metal play park structures would have some maintenance carried out, eg removing surface rust etc. and this should give them around another 18 months of life when, hopefully, the new play park in the Palm Cross Green development will be available.

Two planning applications were passed with no objections. The matter had been raised about HGVs using Back Street and the parking on the corner by Corner Cottage. This is causing problems with emergency vehicles and this matter will be raised at SHDC, as will a suggestion for a sign by the War Memorial to request that people do not park there.

A draft Development Site option appraisal was presented by the Neighbourhood Plan group to the Parish Council for approval which was given. This document will be forwarded to SHDC for their consideration subject to the results of the Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire. This document can be seen on the Neighbourhood Plan website.

An application is being made for a grant to provide between 4-6 bike stands, possibly with a bike shelter, to be placed in Poundwell car park.

Meetings are on going concerning the provision of a bus stop in the new development and would hope to have more news next month.

Representations about the closure of Lloyds Bank in Modbury and other locations in the South Hams have been made, the Parish Council will follow up on this matter.

District Council Report

Business Engagement and Support

I am pleased to announce that SHDC have agreed to commission business support from BIP (Business Information Point) to support up to 100 existing businesses and start ups across the South Hams. The decision was taken after my economy working group thoroughly investigated the work of BIP looking at its effectiveness in terms of facilitating start ups, job creation and growth of existing business. I am also working with the Joint Local Plan team to continue to achieve a good strategic plan for the economy and to ensure the right policy development for supporting the rural economy.

Joint Local Plan Update

I arranged for representatives from Modbury Neighbourhood Plan Group to meet with the lead strategic planner to discuss possible alternatives to the current preferred site for housing for the next 20 years. Modbury have had the opportunity to put forward alternative sites.

I have advised the Joint Local Plan team that on the basis of the response to the summer consultation and the Modbury public meeting I cannot support the planners current preferred site. I do not support the large single block and the certain detrimental impact this will have on the character of the town - noting that I live adjacent to the current development site. I hope that Modbury can put forward balanced alternatives.

New Mills Industrial Estate

An action plan has been developed between SHDC, the Modbury Chamber of Trade and with support of he Modbury Society to improve the appearance of the entrance to the New Mills business estate. There are great businesses in this estate and we want to enable them to flourish whilst making this gateway area as attractive as it can be.

Energy Advisors from SDCE will be on hand, in the Modbury Parish office, to help residents check their fuel bills and energy deals on Saturday 14th January and Saturday 28th January from 10-12.30.

All the advice is free and impartial and is funded through the national Big Energy Saving Network. Residents who haven't switched energy supplier in the last 5 years are likely to be on the standard variable tariff and could be paying $\pounds100-300$ more than they need to every year. Please pop along to the free sessions in January and find out how much you could save.



At the time of writing, with completed questionnaires still being counted, it is clear that we have achieved a very satisfactory response rate from which the views of residents of Modbury Parish can be well represented in the planning process.

I would also like to thank all the members of the NPG who put in a lot of hard work designing the questionnaire, organising distribution and collection, organising the site information display and delivering and collecting questionnaires. All NPG members are volunteers and have given generously of their time and effort.

So what happens now?






This year's Poppy Appeal in Modbury raised £6,603,




